City of SPLIT

Split is an important historical, administrative, economic, cultural, collegiate, tourist and sports center of Croatia. It is the largest city in the region of Dalmatia and the second largest city in Croatia. In addition to this, it is also the second largest Croatian sea port and the third largest on the Mediterranean coast based on the number of its passengers.

Diocletian's palace, which dates back to antiquity, or more precisely the 4th century AD, forms the core of the city itself. It was from this palace that Split developed. Nowadays, Split has over 190 thousand inhabitants. Along with its neighboring cities (Trogir, Kaštela, Solin, Sinj, Omiš and Supetar and the other small towns scattered on the islands of Brač and Šolta), Split has around 400 thousand inhabitants. This number can go up to 1 million people if the residents of the broader areas of Central Dalmatia and Bosnia and Hercegovina are included. The patron of Split is Saint Domnius in whose honor a large celebration is held every year on May 7. All the inhabitants of Split and many guests from the surrounding towns as well as from around the world take part in this festivity.

There are currently 12 functioning faculties and 7 scientific institutes in the city. The prolific cultural life of the town is nourished in the many museums and galleries as well as the Croatian National Theater.

Split is also an important tourist center. Millions of tourists come from around the world to see the remains of Emperor Diocletian's palace but also to enjoy the sea, food, merriment and company of the local people.
